## COVID-19 Vaccine Bus Route Instructions

To fight back against the COVID-19 pandemic, Bell County will be providing first-dose vaccinations at the following locations:

Sammons Community Center 2220 W. Avenue D Temple, TX 76504

Killeen Community Center 2201 E. Veterans Memorial Blvd. Killeen, TX 76543

In addition, second-dose vaccinations will be provided at the following location:

Bell County Expo Center 301 W. Loop 121 Belton, TX 76513

In order to assist with the distribution of the COVID-19 vaccine, Hill Country Transit District (HCTD), also known as The HOP, will be providing feeder routes in addition to our usual bus service to allow easy access to vaccination sites.

To access the site in Temple at the Sammons Community Center, take either the RT-510 or RT-530 (schedules and stops are available on Google Maps and on HCTD's website at <a href="www.takethehop.com">www.takethehop.com</a>. Bus trips cost \$1.00). When boarding, ask the driver for a transfer ticket, and then disembark the vehicle at the Temple Transfer Station in downtown Temple. The Feeder route will pick up passengers at thirty minutes past every hour from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, and take them to the Sammons Community Center. After receiving the vaccination, return to the bus location and present the transfer ticket in order to board the bus and then be returned to the Temple Transfer Station.

To access the site in Killeen at the Killeen Community Center, take either the RT-2 or RT-4 (schedules and stops are available on Google Maps and on HCTD's website at <a href="www.takethehop.com">www.takethehop.com</a>. Bus trips cost \$1.00). When boarding, ask the driver for a transfer ticket, and then disembark the vehicle at the Killeen Transfer Station in downtown Killeen. An additional pickup location will be at the Scott and White Killeen Clinic as accessible from RT-4, RT-35, and RT-200. The Feeder route will pick up passengers from the Killeen Transfer Station at the top of every hour from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, and take them to the Killeen Community Center. Passengers may board the Feeder Route at the Scott and White Killeen Clinic at 0:35 after every hour. After receiving the vaccination, return to the bus location and present the transfer ticket in order to board the bus and then be returned to the Killeen Transfer Station or Scott and White Killeen Clinic to return home.


When receiving the second vaccination at the Bell County Expo Center, simply take any route and relevant connections to RT-610 (schedules and stops are available on Google Maps and on HCTD's website at <a href="https://www.takethehop.com">www.takethehop.com</a>. Bus trips cost \$1.00). When boarding, ask the driver for a transfer ticket, and then disembark the vehicle at the Bell County Expo Center. After receiving the vaccination, return to the bus

stop and present the transfer ticket in order to board the bus and then take The HOP to return to Killeen or Temple.

Passengers that qualify for ADA service can have rides scheduled to take them directly to the vaccination sites. To schedule a trip, simply call The HOP at (254) 933-3700.
